

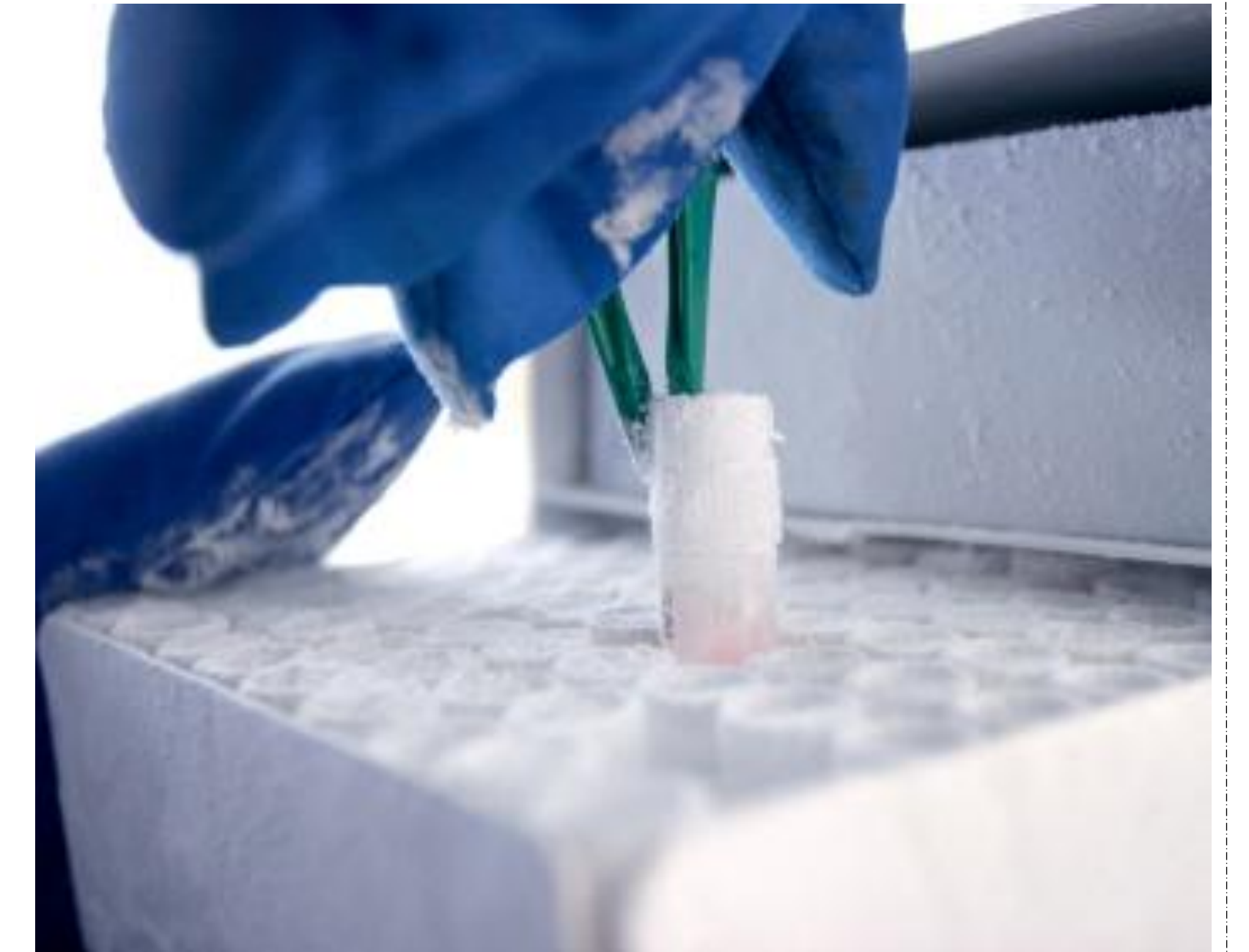

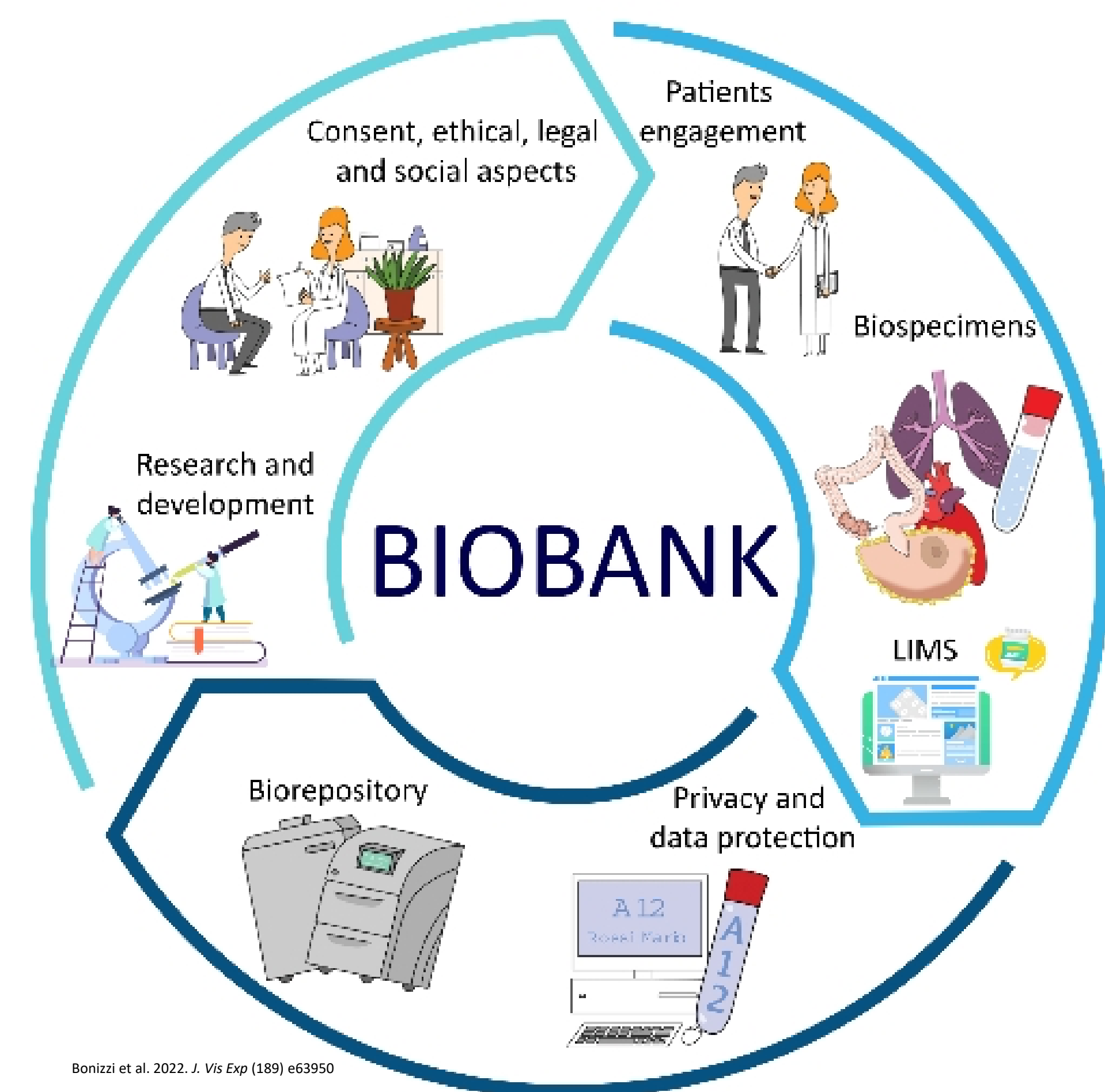


## *We Need Your Help!*

### Needs Assessment Survey of the Biobanking Community:

ACCESS National Biobanking Network was established to identify, prioritize and address key biobanking community needs that impede research progress in the areas of pediatric, adolescent and young adult cancers. To best develop this important research tool and help maximize research impact for pediatric and young adult cancer patients, we need your help! A **Needs Assessment Survey** has been created to target the biobanking community, including biobankers, researchers, persons with lived experience (PWLE), health care professionals and any other stakeholders.

The questions in this survey are an extension of previously identified themes of increasing opportunities to participate in biobanking, creating a virtual biobanking platform, and creating resources for or sharing biobanking knowledge with stakeholders. Needs could include educational support, support for increasing capacity in biospecimen collection and annotation, improving the visibility of samples and improved accessibility of samples.
